## NORTH GOA

- Enjoy your breakfast.

### Anjuna Beach

- This beach is characterized by jagged laterite boulders and bewitching red cliffs which overlook the sandy shoreline with the waves pounding them repeatedly. The relaxed vibe of the locals here, combined with the electric vibe in the air, is sure to win your heart.



### Fort Aguada, Goa

- Although Fort Aguada presently serves as the Central Jail, it has witnessed numerous historical battles and events that have directly affected the fort itself. Built in 1609–12, it is the largest and the best preserved bastion in Goa. It was built to protect Old Goa from external enemy attacks.

### Calangute Beach

- Also visit Calangute Beach, which is the largest in North Goa.

# Day 02



## Baga Beach

- Proceed to Baga Beach, which is in proximity to Calangute Beach. Baga Beach has a lot in store like exciting nightlife, flea market, and eating-joints to keep its visitors intrigued.

## Vagator Beach

- Vagator Beach boasts a lovely silver sandy stretch with enormous red cliffs overlooking it. One can also find two fresh bubbling springs in close proximity to the shore that appear quite enchanting.

## Mapusa

- In Mapusa, the visitors can select from a wide range of sightseeing options, from bustling bazaars to historical forts that are visually appealing, besides being great historical attractions.

## Shri Bodgegshwar Temple

- Located in close proximity to Mapusa about 12 km from Panaji is the Shri Bodgegshwar Temple. The temple, located in a lush green environment, is home to a small shrine dedicated to Kanakeshwar Baba or Bodgegshwar, locally known as Bongini.

## SOUTH GOA

- Enjoy your breakfast.

### Shri Shantadurga Temple & Shri Mangesh Temple

- Begin your tour by seeking blessings at Shri Shantadurga Temple and Shri Mangesh Temple

### Se Cathedral Church

- Later, pay homage to Se Cathedral Church: This religious shrine, which is one of the most ancient and famous buildings in all of Goa, is dedicated to St. Catherine of Alexandria. Commissioned in the year 1631, the construction of this building took more than 62 years.

### Basilica de Bom Jesus

- Constructed in 1605, the Basilica is one of the foremost attractions of Goa.
- It is famous for containing the tomb and mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier, who is believed to be one of the patron saints of Goa by the Catholics. Constructed in Portuguese style, the basilica is eminent for its architecture.



# Day 03

## SOUTH GOA



### Palolem Beach

- Palolem Beach is where you let go all your worries and accumulated stress and simply have a great time. The greatest attraction of this beach is its raw preserved beauty. This beach is inhabited by local fishermen and foreign tourists who stay in shacks along the shore or in the main village itself. Also known as the Paradise Beach of India, this beach is visited by tourists throughout the year and includes both domestic and international travelers.

### Dona Paula Bay

- View the Mormugao Harbour from the Dona Paula Bay. Mormugao Harbour is among the top-notch natural harbors of the country, dating back to the Portuguese era.

### Panjim Bazar

- The River Mandovi, after travelling the length and breadth of Goa, makes its way to the Arabian Sea, thus presenting an enchanting sight. One can view this spectacular sight from the Miramar Beach, which provides splendid views

### Return to hotel

- Tip: While sampling feni, the local liquor, limit the amount you drink. It tastes smooth, but is potent.

## GOA – AT LEISURE

### Option A (Nature): Dudhsagar Falls

- Dedicate the day to a trip to Dudhsagar Waterfalls. It involves a jeep safari through the Bhagwan Mahavir Wildlife Sanctuary

# Practical Tips

## FOR INTERNATIONAL VISITORS



Visa	Most nationalities need an e-Visa. Apply at <a href="http://indianvisaonline.gov.in">indianvisaonline.gov.in</a> at least 4 days before travel.
Health	No mandatory vaccines, but Hepatitis A, Typhoid & Tetanus are recommended. Carry prescription medicines.
Getting Around	Use app-cabs (Goa Miles / Rapido), hired taxis, or rent a scooter (~₹400/day). Negotiate taxi fares upfront.
Food & Water	Drink only bottled or filtered water. Try the prawn curry-rice and fish thali – Goa's local specialties.
Dress Code	Beach wear on beaches. Cover shoulders & knees when visiting temples and churches.
Connectivity	Buy a SIM (Airtel / Jio) at the airport. Good 4G coverage across Goa.
Weather	Nov–Feb: 22–32°C (72–90°F), dry & pleasant. Avoid June–September (heavy monsoon).
Emergency	Police: 100   Ambulance: 102   Tourist Helpline: 1364

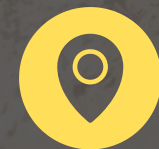
