DAY 01

ITINERARY DETAILS

KOCHI (COCHIN)- MUNNAR

- Arrive at Kochi (Cochin) Airport and depart by road towards Munnar.
- A scenic drive of approximately 160 km / 5 hours through winding Western Ghats roads.
- Arrive Munnar – one of the most popular hill stations in South India.
- Check into your hotel and freshen up.
- An evening stroll through the sprawling tea gardens near your hotel
- The rest of the day at leisure – soak in the cool mountain air and lush greenery.



DAY 02

ITINERARY DETAILS

MUNNAR - CITY TOUR

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit the picturesque Mattupetty Dam – enjoy optional boating on the scenic reservoir.
- Proceed to Echo Point – a natural phenomenon where sound echoes across the valley.
- Explore Top Station – offering breathtaking panoramic views of the Western Ghats.
- Visit Eravikulam National Park – home to the endangered Nilgiri Tahr and stunning shola forests.
- Stop at Anamudi – the highest peak in South India at 2,695 m
- Tea Factory Visit (approx. 2–3 hrs) – walk through lush tea plantations and meet local farmers.
- Witness the full tea production process – from leaf to cup – using traditional manufacturing techniques
- Refine your palate with a curated tea tasting session at the factory





DAY 03

ITINERARY DETAILS

MUNNAR- THEKKADY

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Depart by road to **Thekkady** – a scenic drive of approximately 110 km / 4 hours.
- Arrive in Thekkady, transfer to the hotel, check in, and freshen up.
- **Late afternoon:** Visit the celebrated Kathakali Show – a classical dance-drama featuring elaborate makeup, ornate costumes, and a rich, gesture-based language that narrates epic tales from the Ramayana and Mahabharata.

Tip: Arrive 30 minutes early to witness the fascinating, intricate backstage makeup preparation.



ITINERARY DETAILS

THEKKADY

- **Evening:** Experience the Kalaripayattu Show — the world's oldest martial art form and the acknowledged mother of all martial arts
- Rooted in a 3,000-year-old tradition, Kalaripayattu was gifted to the world by the sage Parasurama, the master of all martial arts, who is also credited with reclaiming Kerala from the Arabian Sea.
- A living legend: the famous Kung Fu of the Shaolin Temple traces its lineage to Bodhi Dharma, an Indian Buddhist monk and Kalaripayattu master — connecting ancient Kerala to global martial arts heritage



DAY 04

ITINERARY DETAILS

Thekkady — Spice Plantation · Elephant Safari · Periya

- Breakfast at the hotel
- At 10:00 AM — embark on a thrilling **Elephant Safari** through the lush forest trails of Thekkady.
- On return, depart for an immersive **Spice Plantation Tour** — a journey deep into the fragrant heart of Kerala's spice country.
- Visit the **Cardamom Curing Centre** to understand the spice processing industry and experience the aroma of freshly cured cardamom.
- Explore a working plantation growing a **wide variety of spices**, including vanilla, black pepper, cloves, nutmeg and mace — all set amidst lush coconut palms, banana groves and towering jackfruit trees.

Thekkady — Spice Plantation · Elephant Safari · Periya

- Noon: Visit the legendary **Periyar National Park & Tiger Reserve** — one of India's most celebrated wildlife sanctuaries.
- Take a scenic **boat cruise on Periyar Lake** — gliding past the forest shoreline in search of wild elephants, Indian bison, otters, and a wide variety of exotic birds.
- **Overnight stay in Thekkady**

DAY 05

ITINERARY DETAILS

THEKKADY → ALLEPPEY → KUMARAKOM (AT LEISURE)

- Breakfast at the hotel, depart by road towards Kumarakom.
- En route, **halt at Alleppey** — board a traditional Shikara boat through narrow backwater canals.
- **Village Life** — traditional Kerala houses & local activities along canals like Vilakkumaram.
- **Vembanad Lake** — a vast backwater lake showcasing the true scale of Kerala backwaters.
- **Snake Boat Race Sites** — starting & finishing points of the famous Nehru Trophy Race.
- **Kuttanad Region** — unique paddy fields cultivated below sea level (C-Block)

ALLEPPEY > KUMARAKOM (AT LEISURE)

- **Proceed to Kumarakom** — a scenic backwater destination near Kottayam, famous for its backwater tourism.
- Proceed to Kumarakom after the **Alleppey backwater experience**
- Located near the city of Kottayam, Kerala.
- Famous for its stunning backwater tourism.
- Set on the banks of **Vembanad Lake**, the largest freshwater lake in Kerala.
- On arrival, transfer to the hotel & check in.
- Rest of the day at leisure / on your own

DAY 06

Kumarakom — Wellness / Spa / Ayurveda (At Leisure)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Full day at **leisure** — relax and unwind on your own
- **Pamper yourself** with an Ayurveda treatment (at your own expense)
- **Ayurveda** — The Science of Life: A 5,000-year-old Indian healing system that treats the root cause of stress & fatigue, not just the symptoms
- **A trained practitioner** (Vaidya) assesses your body type — Vata (air), Pitta (fire) or Kapha (earth) — and selects specific oils & techniques suited to you personally
- Unlike a standard spa, Ayurveda works on **balancing your body** energies (doshas) to improve immunity, skin texture and mental clarity.
- Overnight stay in Kumarakom



DAY 07

Kumarakom → Houseboat → Alleppey

- Transfer to the jetty to board your **private houseboat**.
- **Set sail at 12:00 PM** — cruise through the scenic backwaters and lush paddy fields towards Alleppey.
- **Reach R-Block** — a magnificent 3,000-acre island in Vembanad Lake, lying below sea level, surrounded by shimmering backwaters.
- Visit **Pathiramanal Island** — a mystical island steeped in legend, said to have magically emerged from the depths of the lake.
- Houseboat sailing hours: 12:00 PM to 5:30 PM, followed by an overnight anchorage amidst the **tranquil backwaters**.
- Morning cruise: 7:30 AM to 9:00 AM — a peaceful final glide through the **waterways**.
- Enjoy the comfort of a **private crew & onboard chef** — all meals freshly prepared and included on board.
- **Overnight on Houseboat**





DAY 08

ITINERARY DETAILS

Alleppey → Kochi (Cochin)

- Breakfast on board; **disembark at Alleppey Jetty** at 09:00 AM
- Depart by road to **Kochi (Cochin)**
- On arrival, embark on a half-day city tour of **historic Fort Cochin**
- **St. Francis Church** — India's oldest European church, built in 1503 by the Portuguese; a landmark of colonial heritage
- **Chinese Fishing Nets** — iconic cantilevered nets strung along the Fort Cochin waterfront, a timeless symbol of Kerala
- **Mattancherry Palace (Dutch Palace)** — originally built by the Portuguese in 1557 and gifted to Raja Veera Kerala Varma of Cochin; later renovated by the Dutch after 1663



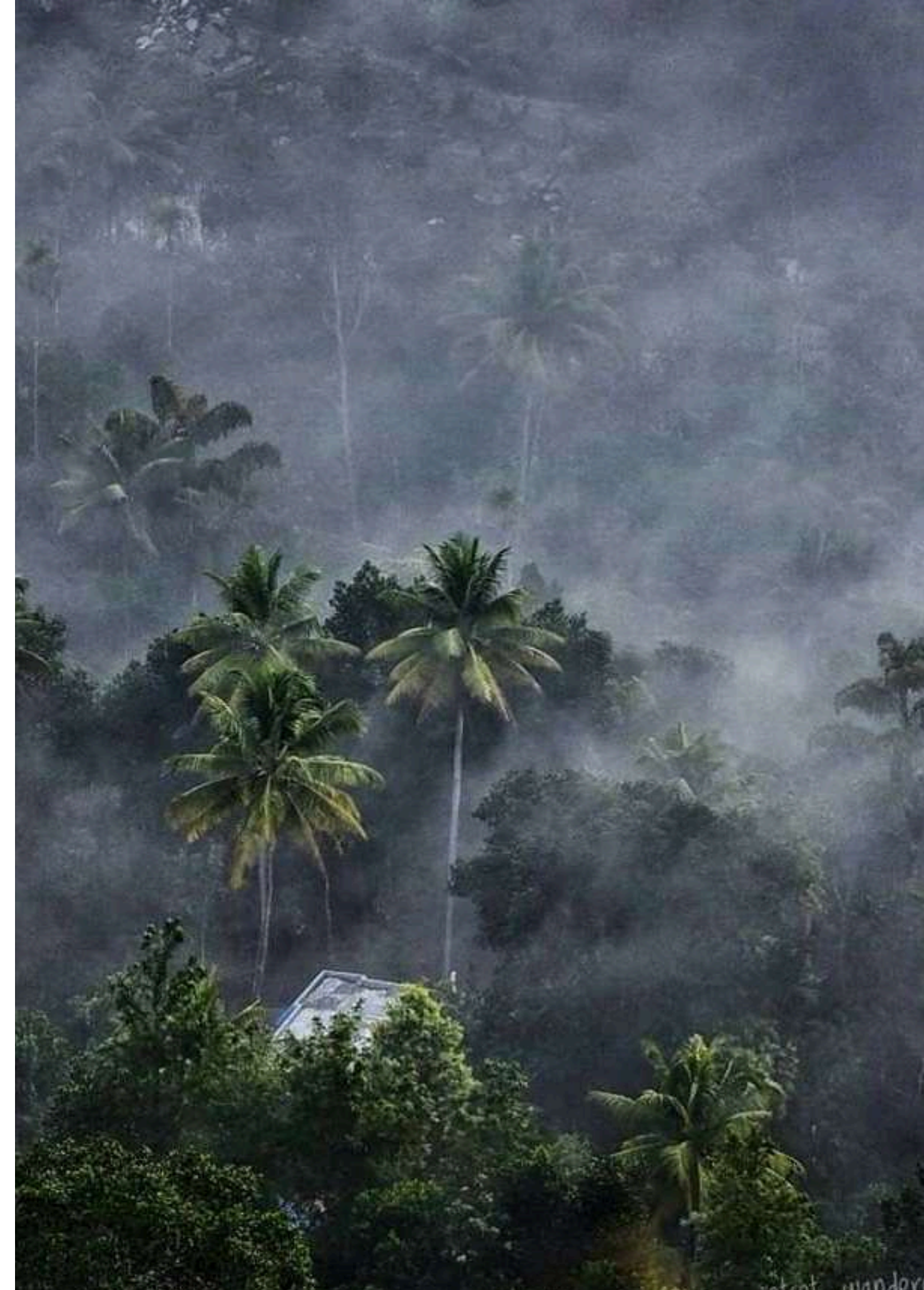
Alleppey → Kochi (Cochin)

- Transfer to the hotel and check in
- **Evening – Nilavala Experience:** A magical twilight dining event set on a traditional fishing net platform over the backwaters – begin with a 30-minute sunset boat ride, then settle in for a candlelit dinner under the open sky, savouring freshly prepared local Kerala cuisine in a truly one-of-a-kind setting
- **Overnight stay in Kochi**

DAY 09

Kochi (Cochin) – airport

- **Breakfast at the hotel**
- Transfer to **Kochi International Airport** for your onward journey
- Bid farewell to God's Own Country — carrying memories of misty hills, tranquil backwaters & vibrant culture
- Tour Ends — Safe Travels!

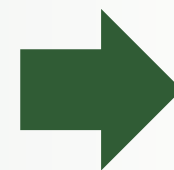

- Sleep aboard a traditional houseboat as it drifts through narrow lakes and canals

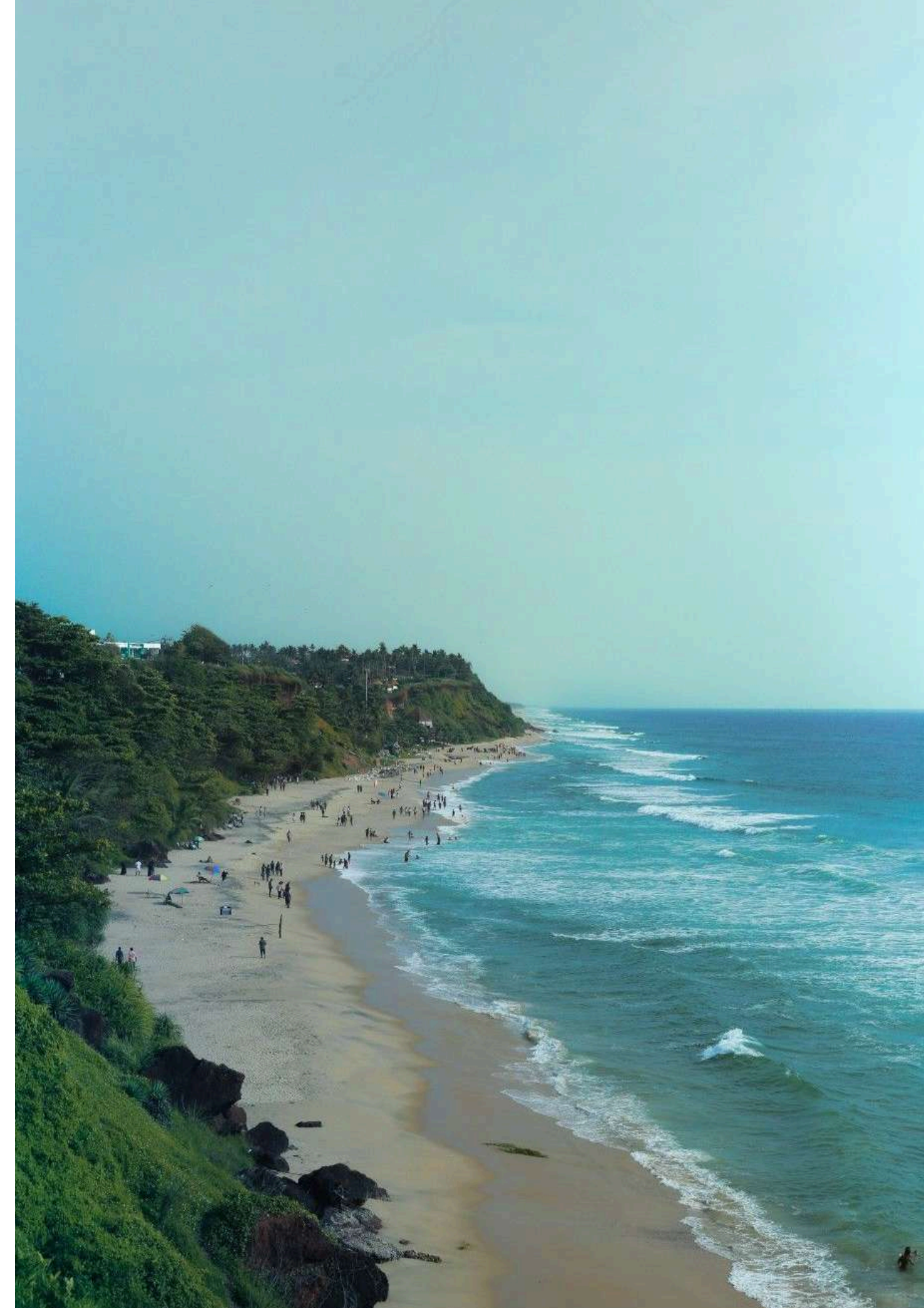

- Wellness Haven — traditional Ayurvedic treatments and yoga at world-class eco-resorts and homestays

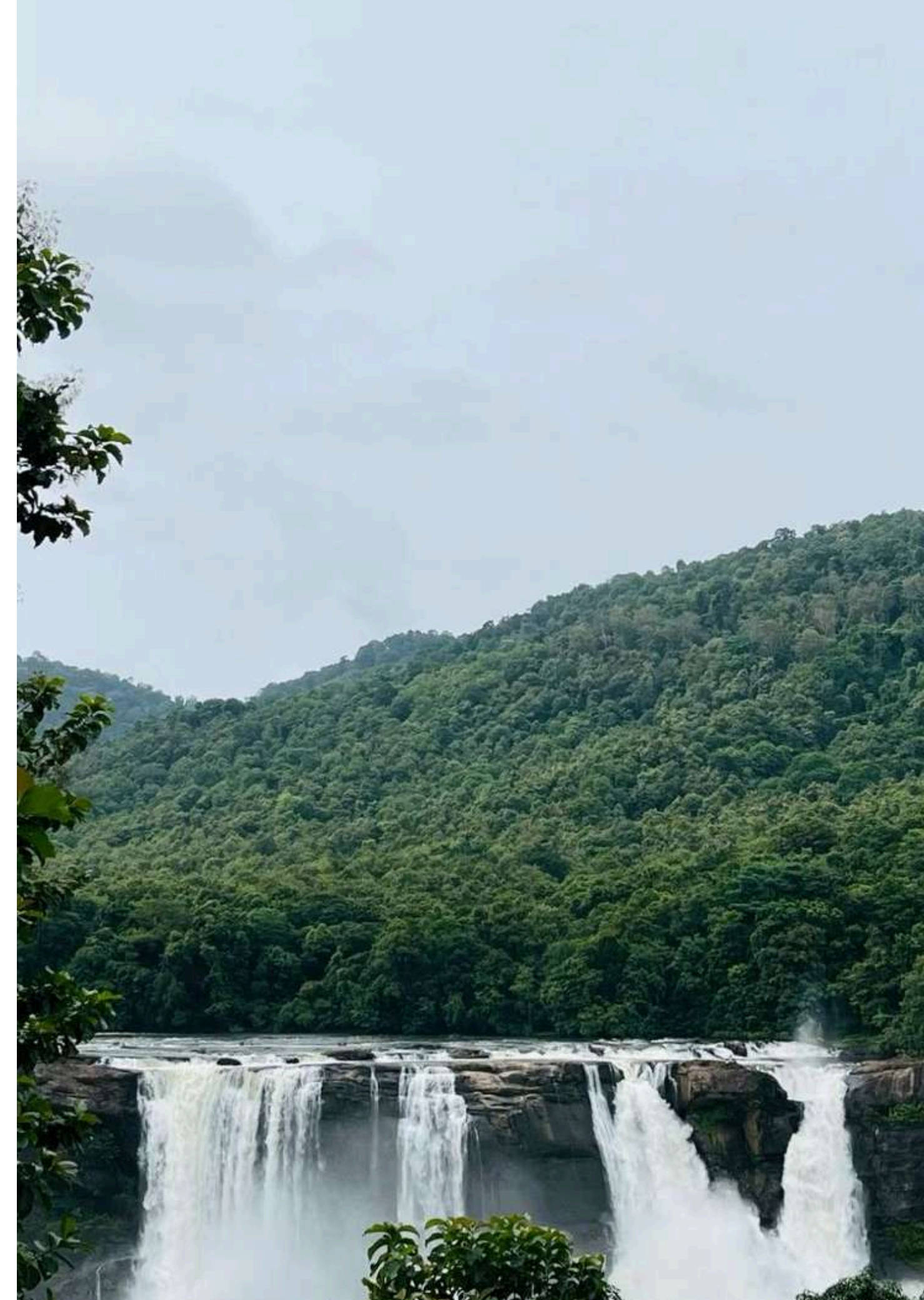

ATHIRAPPILLY **2 Nights**

- Home to Kerala's most spectacular waterfall — the 'Niagara of South India' — dropping 80 feet across a 330-foot cliff, a backdrop for iconic films like Bahubali.
- Athirappilly Waterfalls — view from the top for panoramic vistas or trek to the base to feel the thundering mist
- Vazhachal Waterfalls — 5 km upstream, a rocky horizontal rush through dense birdwatcher's forest
- Thumboormuzhi Butterfly Park — 148+ butterfly species, scenic hanging bridge and family-friendly gardens
- Charpa Waterfalls — a seasonal roadside waterfall that splashes directly onto the highway during the monsoon
- Lower Sholayar Dam — one of Asia's largest rock dams with panoramic Western Ghats views & elephant sightings
- Jungle Safari — forest department-guided tour through Sholayar Rainforest, home to all four South Indian hornbill species

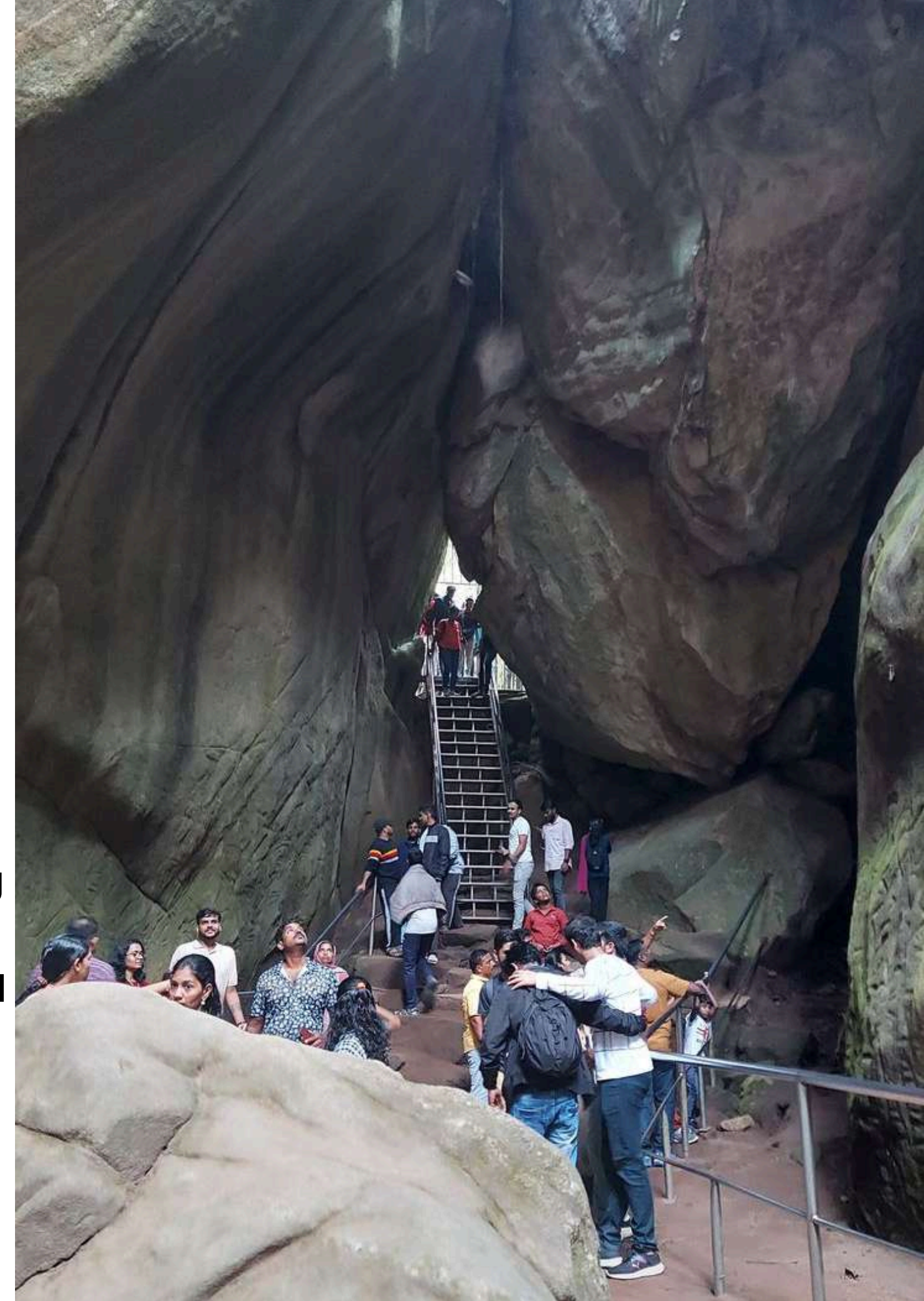

VYTHIRI & WAYANAD 2 Nights

- A misty highland wilderness in Kerala's Western Ghats — lush rainforests, ancient caves, spice-scented air and legendary eco-resorts.
- Thamarassery Churam — dramatic ghat pass with panoramic views across 9 hairpin bends
- Chembra Peak (2,100 m) — moderate trek to a heart-shaped lake said to never dry up
- Edakkal Caves — prehistoric rock carvings dating back over 6,000 years into the Neolithic age
- Banasura Sagar Dam — India's largest earthen dam; enjoy speed-boating against a dramatic hill backdrop
- Couch Potato Lake — a lake shaped like the map of India, perfect for pedal boating amid blue water lilies
- Chain Tree of Lakkidi — a legendary Ficus tree bound in chains, steeped in haunting tribal folklore
- Spice Plantations — explore aromatic cardamom and pepper estates tucked into the forest

MUNROE ISLAND 1 Night

- A tranquil cluster of eight islets at the confluence of Ashtamudi Lake and the Kallada River — famous for narrow canals, mangroves and authentic village life.
- Canal Cruises & Canoe Tours — slow glide through palm-lined canals so narrow you can touch the greenery; iconic mangrove archway at sunrise or sunset
- Village Life — watch coir weaving artisans and early-morning toddy tappers at work
- Island Cycling — flat terrain ideal for cycling past hidden prawn farms and small local temples
- Dutch Church (1878) — an isolated colonial-era church on the lake's edge, reached via a mini local adventure
- Kayaking — guided mangrove kayak tours with a traditional Kayal Sadhya lakeside meal

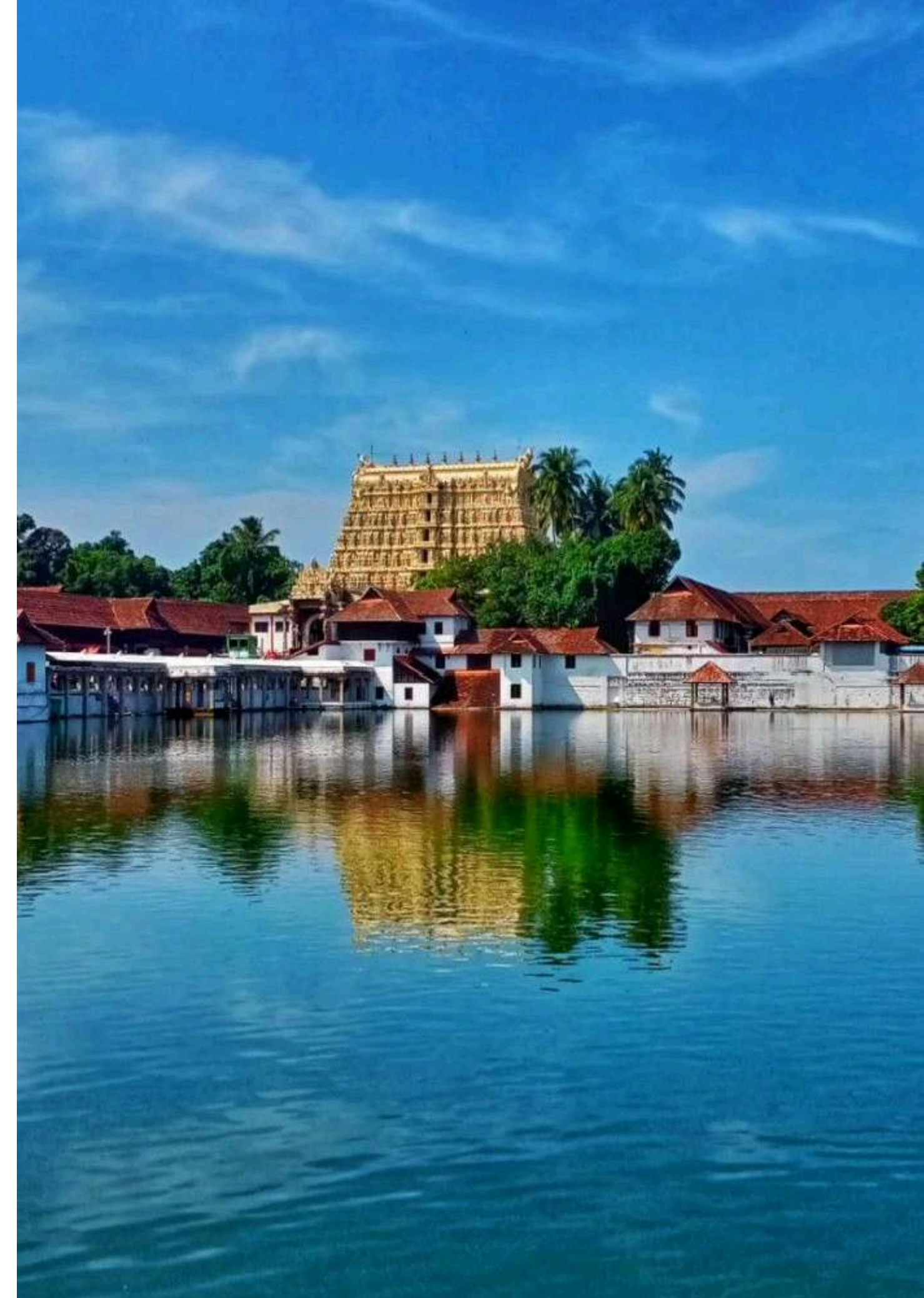

KOVALAM & THIRUVANANTHAPURAM ^{1 Night}

- Kerala's most famous beach destination — crescent bays, a historic lighthouse, Ayurveda retreats, and the cultural riches of the state capital nearby.
- Lighthouse Beach — Kovalam's iconic crescent bay, lined with seafood restaurants and golden sands
- Kovalam Lighthouse — climb to the top for sweeping views of the Arabian Sea coastline
- Ayurveda & Wellness — world-renowned rejuvenation centres along the beachfront
- Thiruvananthapuram — visit the Padmanabhaswamy Temple, Napier Museum & Kerala's rich cultural heritage
