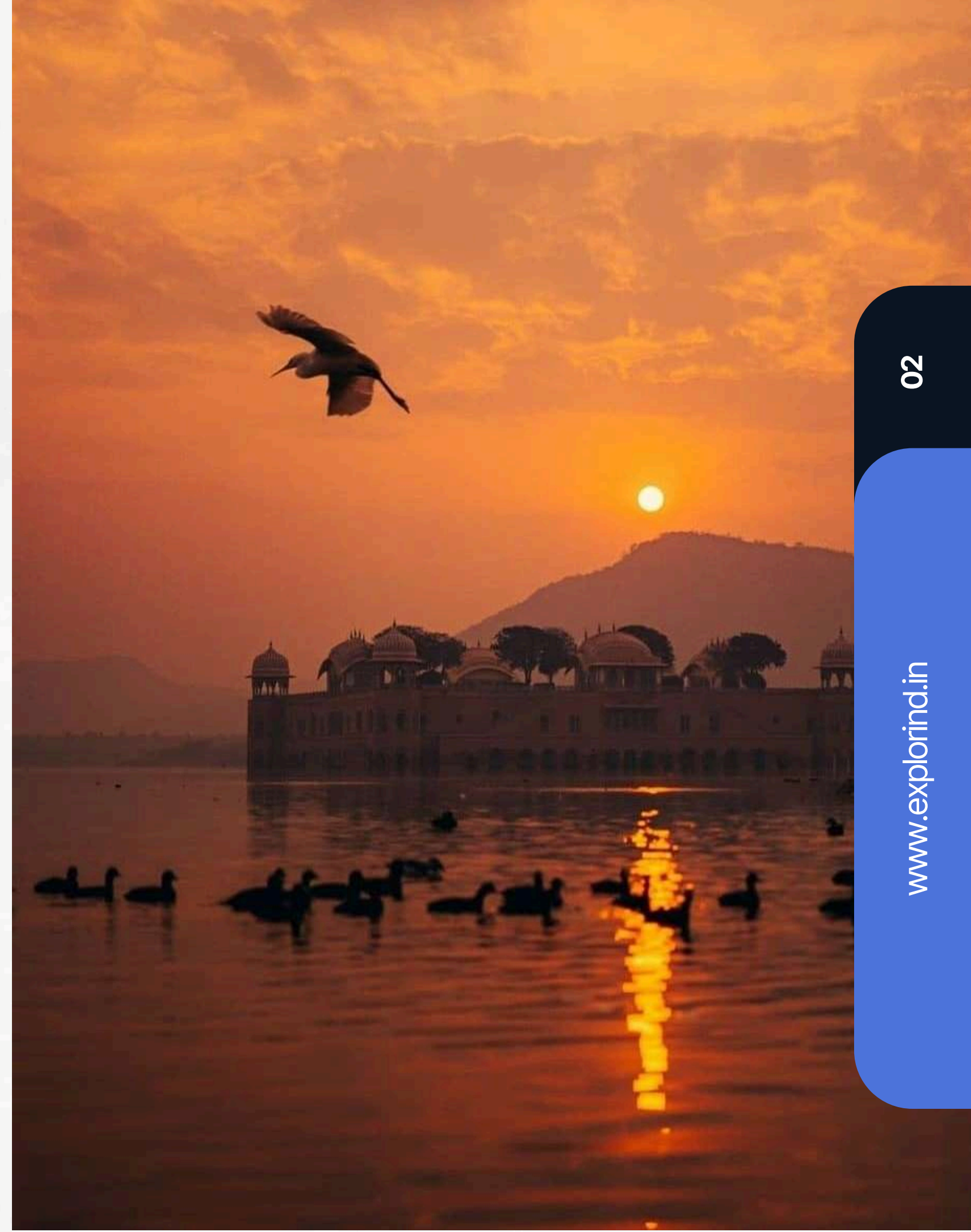
# DAY 01

## ITINERARY DETAILS

# UDAIPUR – CITY TOUR

**Arrival: Arrive in Udaipur and transfer to your hotel.**

- **City Palace:** At noon, visit the City Palace museum. Explore the flawlessly integrated palaces overlooking the clear blue Lake Pichola, formerly the home of Mewar's rulers.
- **Sahelion-ki-bari:** Visit the "Garden of the Maids of Honour," famous for hosting royal parties for centuries.
- **Fateh Sagar Lake:** Enjoy a scenic drive around the lake, excavated in the late 17th century by Maharana Fateh Singh.
- **Lok Kala Mandal:** Pass by the Puppet Museum during your city drive.
- **Moti Magri:** Visit the landmark statue of Maharana Pratap.
- **Lake Boat Ride:** Experience a serene boat ride on the lake.
- **Overnight:** Comfortable stay at your hotel in Udaipur.



# FOOD TO TRY AT LOCAL JOINTS & STALLS

- Poha and Jalebi: Lightly spiced flattened rice with onions and peanuts, paired with hot, crispy jalebis for a classic breakfast.
- Malai Ghewar: A rich, disc-shaped sweet made with ghee and milk, soaked in syrup and topped with fresh cream.
- Dal Baati Churma: Traditional Rajasthani roasted wheat rolls served with spicy lentil curry and sweetened crushed wheat.
- Bun Maska and Chai: A popular comfort snack found in the cafes of the Old City.
- Chaat at Sukhadia Circle or Manek Chowk: Explore local savoury snacks like Pani Puri, Dahi Puri, and Samosas.
- Masala Papad (Open Samosa): An Udaipur speciality featuring a crispy papad base topped with spiced potato and sweet kadhi.

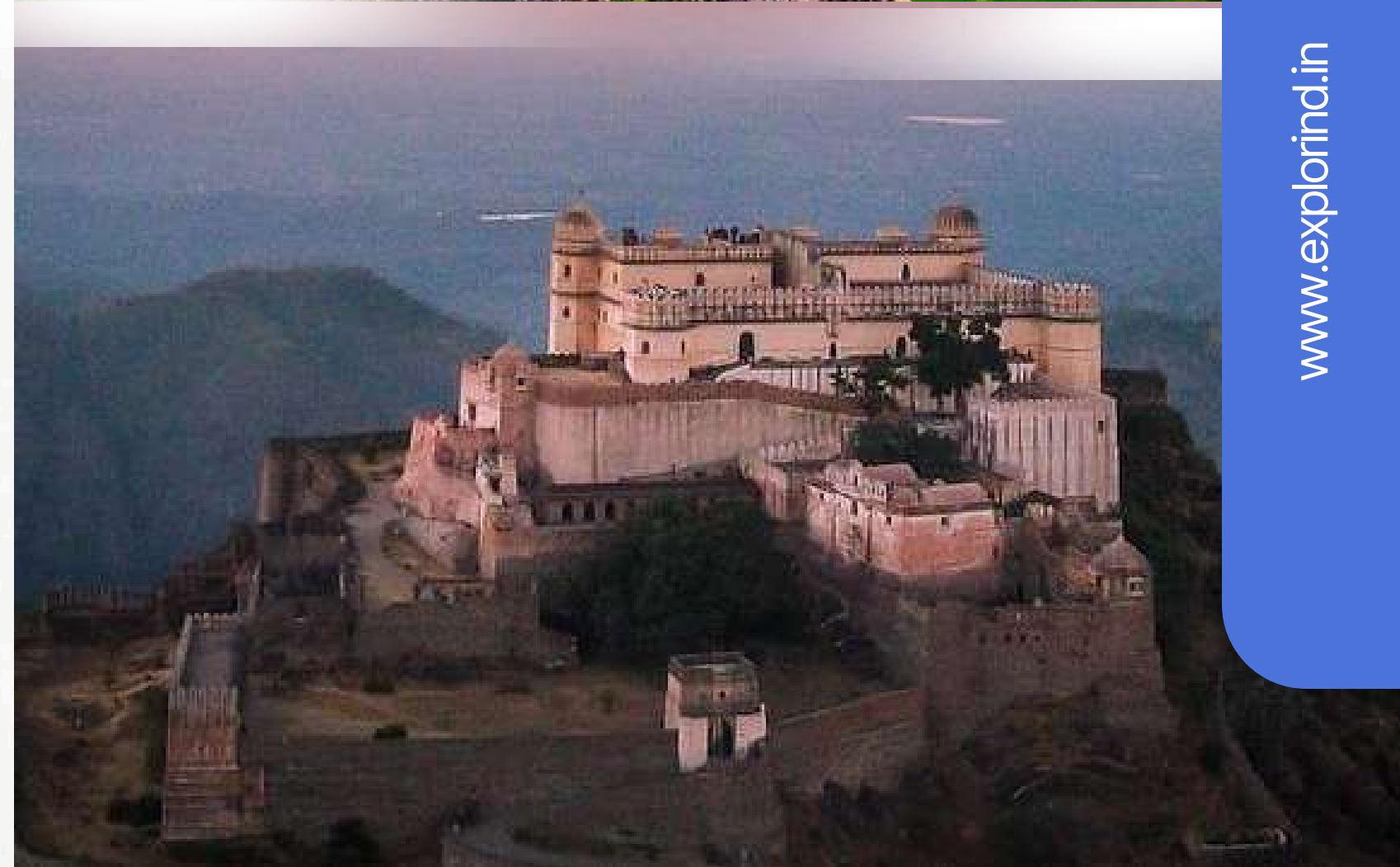

# CHITTORGARH FORT

## The Fort – Overview

- Perched atop a hillock 300 ft high, spreading across 700 acres.
- An architectural marvel that survived three historic ravages.
- UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Houses 65 historic structures
- 20 large temples, palaces, memorials & victory towers.

## Padmini's Palace

- Erstwhile residence of Rani Padmini
- The embodiment of beauty, courage & grace.
- Situated inside the majestic Chittorgarh Fort.
- A beautiful lotus pond is located nearby.

## Vijay Stambh (Victory Tower)

- Built by Maharana Kumbha in 1440 AD.
- A patriotic masterpiece commemorating victory over Mohammed Khilji.

## Fateh Prakash Palace (Govt. Museum)

- Constructed by Maharana Fateh Singh as his royal residence, now a museum.
- Collection includes: wood crafts from Bassi village, ancient weapons (axes, knives, shields),
- clay replicas of regional tribal people in traditional costumes, paintings & crystal ware.



# KUMBHALGARH FORT

- The second most important citadel in Rajasthan, after Chittorgarh.
- Built in the 15th century by Rana Kumbha, nestled in the Aravalli Ranges.
- Birthplace of Mewar's legendary king, Maharana Pratap.
- Served as a refuge for Mewar's rulers in times of strife.
- The Great Wall: A massive fortification wall stretching ~36 km wide enough for eight horses abreast.
- Offers a superb bird's-eye view of the surrounding landscape.
- Renovated by Maharana Fateh Singh in the 19th century.
- The large compound features fascinating ruins – a walk through is highly educational

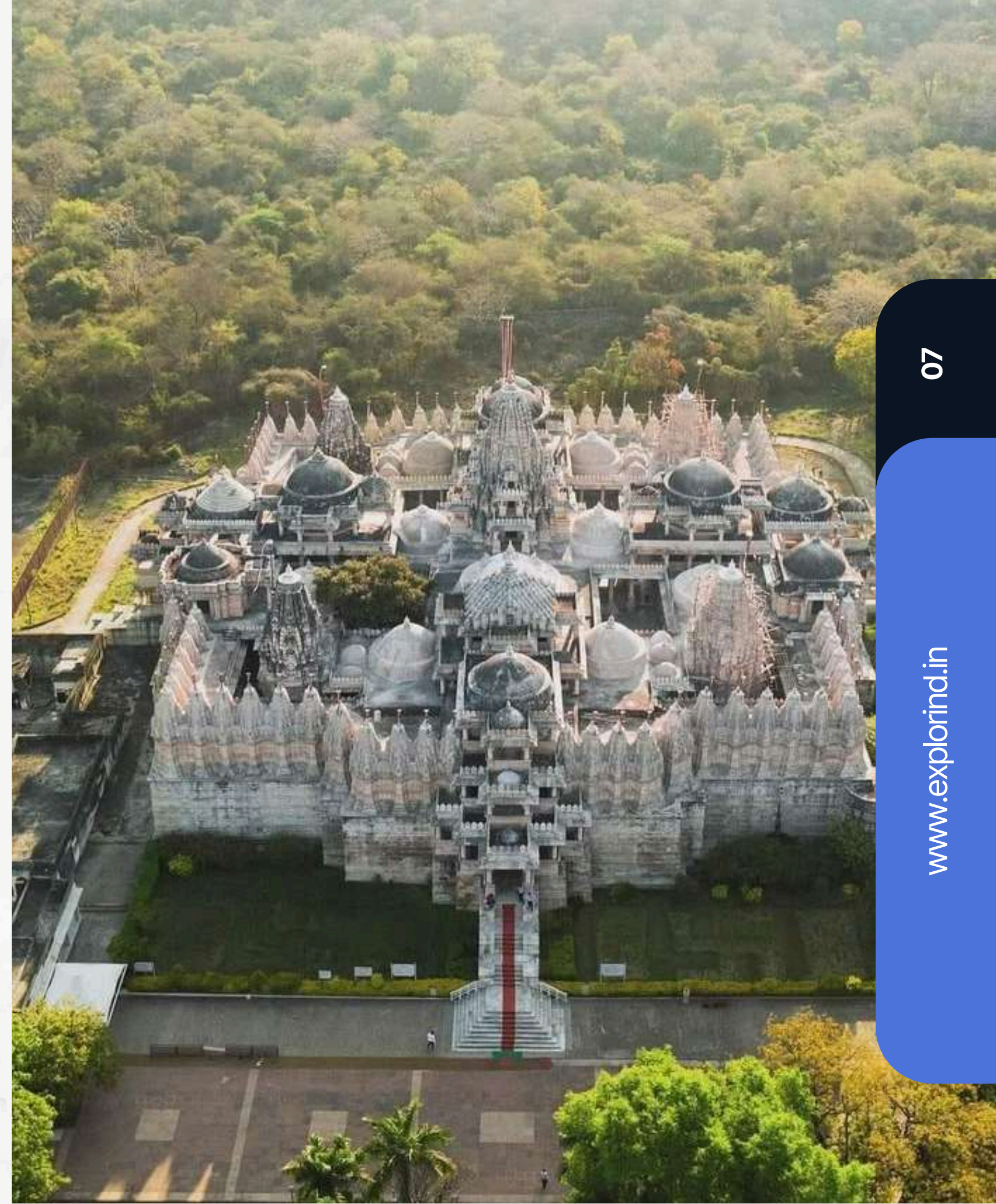
Udaipur › Ranakpur › Rohet

## MORNING

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out and depart for Rohet, with an en route stop at Ranakpur.

## EN ROUTE — RANAKPUR JAIN TEMPLES

- Located ~100 kms from Udaipur, nestled in a deep, secluded valley.
- Home to the most magnificent Jain temples in India.
- A vast complex covering 3,600 sq. metres with 29 halls and 1,444 pillars.
- Each pillar is unique — intricately carved with delicate, geometric designs.
- Architectural marvel: standing near any pillar, you can see the deity in the sanctum.
- The central temple is dedicated to Adinath, the Revealer of Truth.
- Constructed in the early 14th century, a timeless testament to Jain craftsmanship

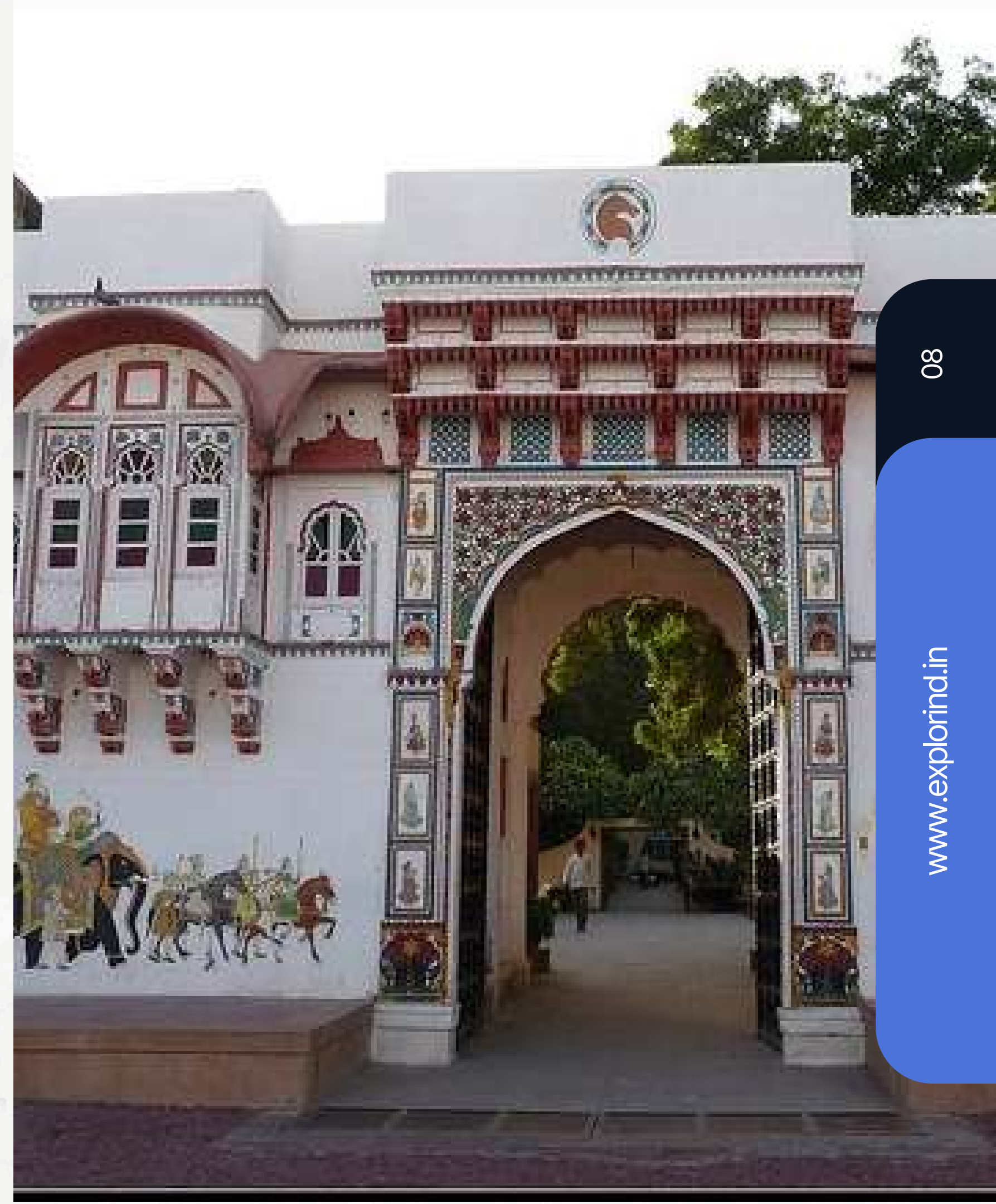

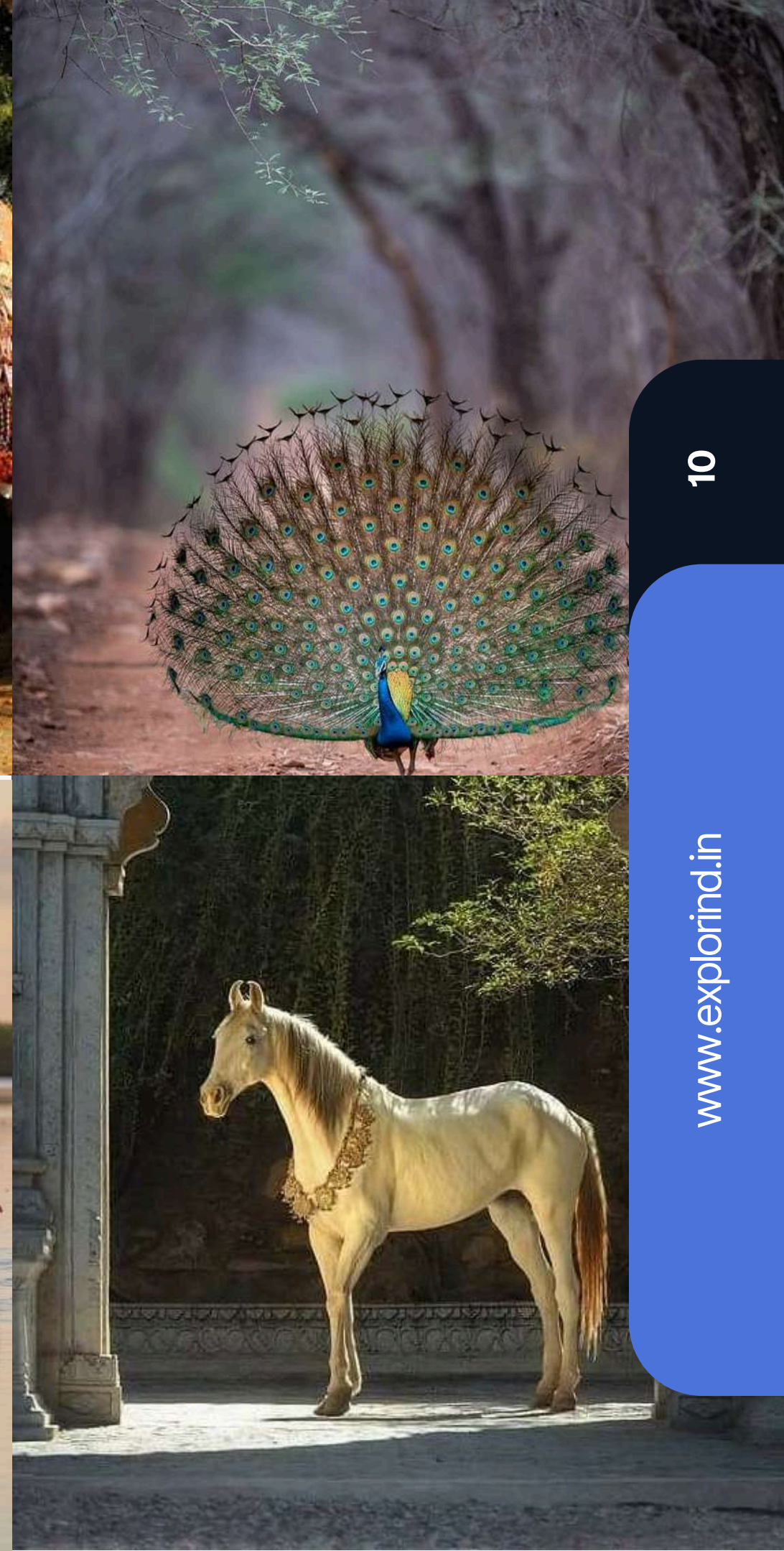

## MORNING

- Take a leisurely morning walk through the gardens to spot peacocks.

- Depart by Jeep or Horse for an immersive village safari through the Bishnoi heartland.





# BISHNOI COMMUNITY

One of Rajasthan's most celebrated eco-communities, the Bishnois are devoted protectors of nature.

Their 500-year-old ethos strictly forbids harming animals or felling green trees.

Wildlife thrives in Bishnoi territory – blackbucks, chinkaras (Indian gazelle), blue bulls (nilgai) and the rare chowsingha (four-horned antelope) graze peacefully alongside their fields.

Return to Rohetgarh as the golden Rajasthani sun sets over the Marwar plains. Freshen up and enjoy a relaxed evening at the heritage fort.

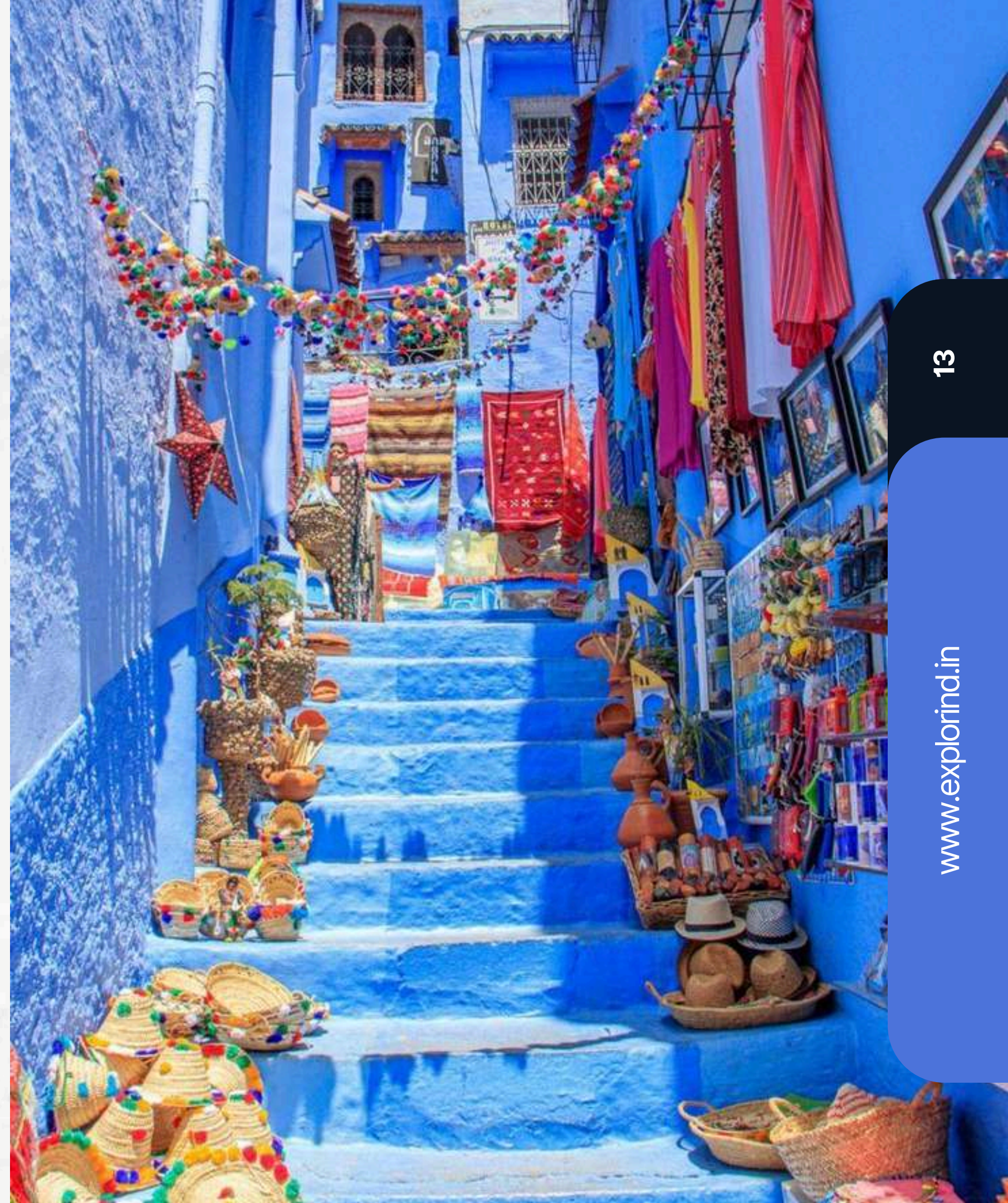
# DAY 05

## ITINERARY DETAILS

Rohet › Jodhpur City

### MORNING

- Breakfast at the hotel in Rohet.
- Check out and drive to Jodhpur — the magnificent 'Blue City' of Rajasthan (1 hr).
- On arrival, proceed directly for a full city tour of Jodhpur.
- About Jodhpur: A city of gentle charm that belies a stormy yet glorious past. Its seven gates, walls, numerous bastions and towers were built in **the 16th century by Rao Maldeo** - a ruler whose legacy still echoes through the city's stones.

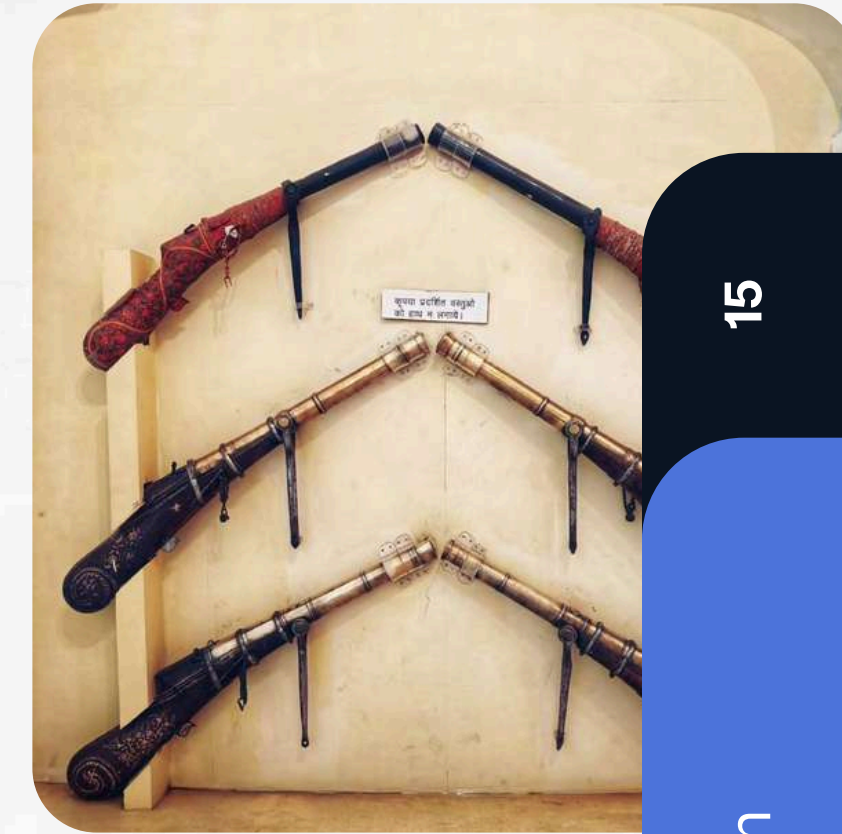

| Meherangarh Fort            | Soars 393 ft above the plains — one of India's largest and most formidable forts. Built in the 16th century. Houses Rajput miniature paintings, Maan Vilas armoury & cannons (the spoils of Gaj Singh). |
| Sardar Bazaar & Clock Tower | Iconic 1912 Clock Tower at the heart of the old city. Vibrant market brimming with spices, textiles, bangles & traditional crafts.                                                                      |
| Jaswant Thada               | A breathtaking white marble cenotaph (chhatri) of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. Situated on the road descending from the fort — often called the 'Taj of Marwar'.                                          |
| Old City Lanes              | A labyrinth of historic lanes lined with palaces, havelis & temples. Home to Jodhpur's famous puppet-makers — a living craft tradition                                                                  |

# INSIDE MEHERANGARH FORT

- **Meherangarh (Majestic) Fort** — commanding the skyline from a bold bluff 393 ft above the plains.
- A **museum** within the fort showcases centuries of Marwar history.
- **Rajput Miniature Paintings** — an exquisite collection of royal-era artwork.
- **Maan Vilas** — the Rathore armoury, housing an impressive array of weapons & royal regalia.
- The **ramparts** display mighty cannons — the spoils of Gaj Singh's conquests.
- On the road descending from the fort: **Jaswant Thada** — the gleaming white marble cenotaph of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II.

## EVENING — BAZAARS & LEISURE

- Evening at leisure — soak in the golden hues of the **Blue City** at sunset.
- No visit to Jodhpur is complete without exploring its **vibrant bazaars**, where the sights, sounds and scents of Rajasthan come alive

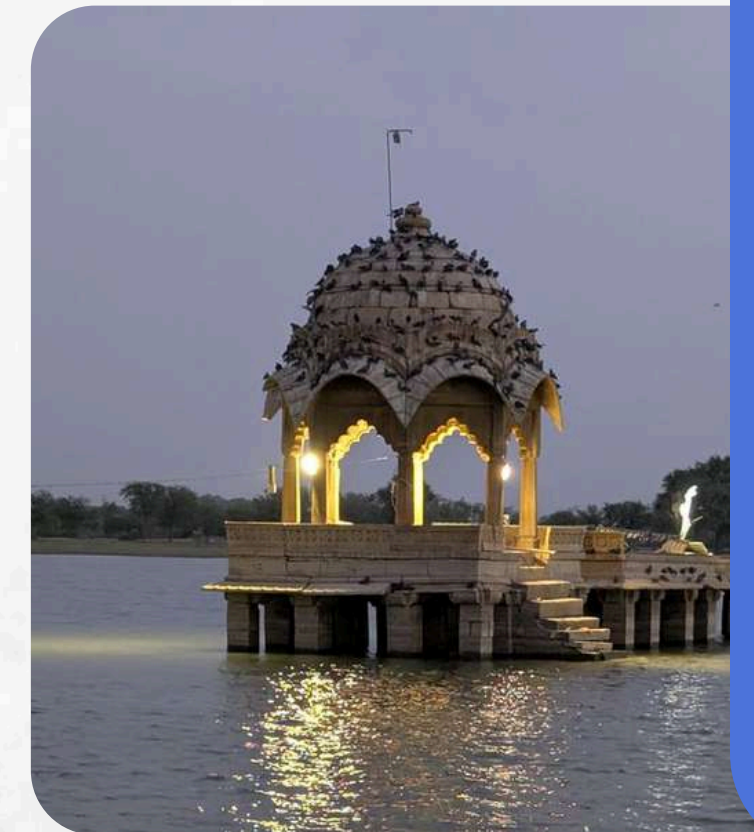
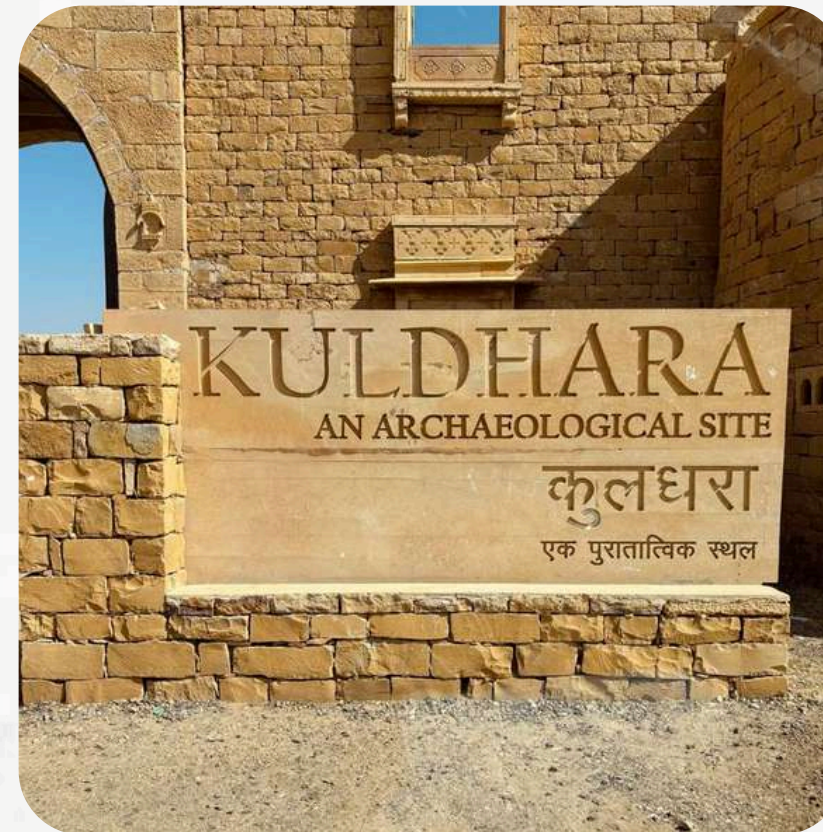
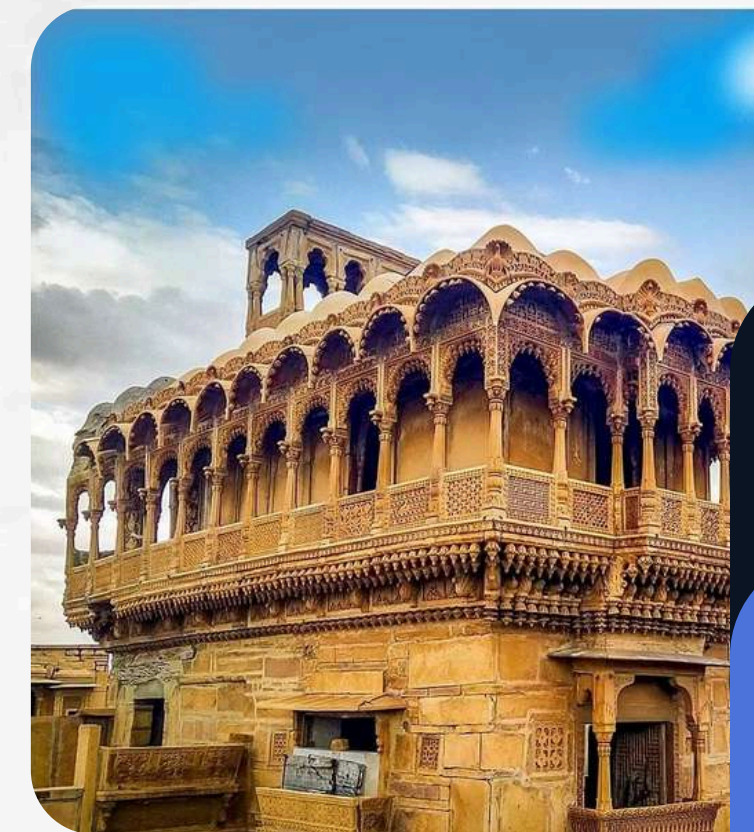
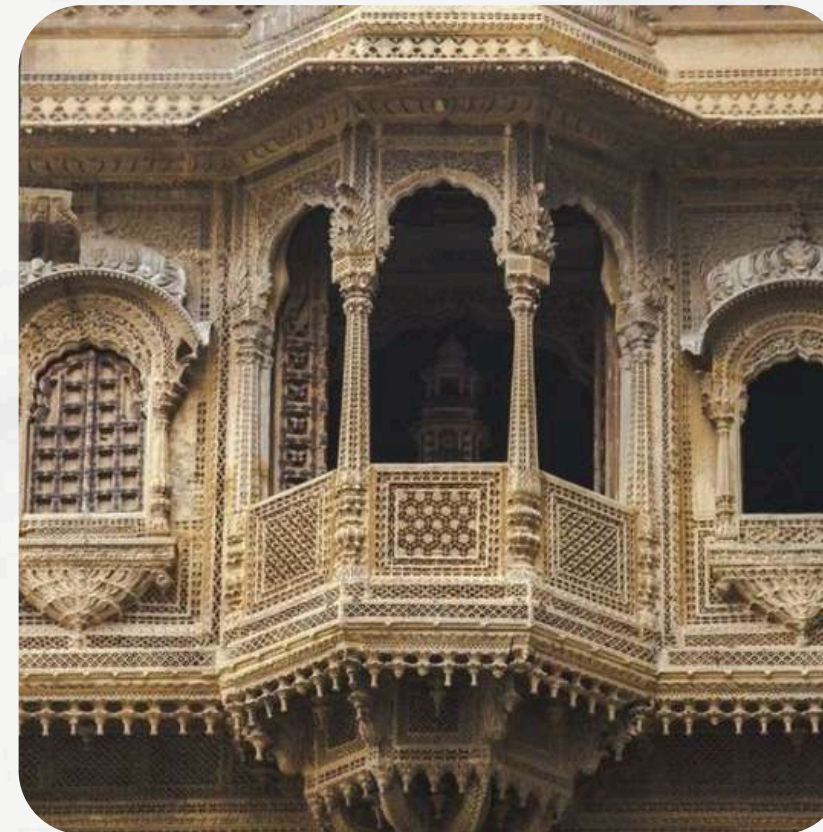
## Jaisalmer City Tour › Kuldhara › Sam Sand Dunes

### Breakfast at the hotel

- Depart for a city tour of Jaisalmer — the legendary Golden City.
- Patwon Ki Haveli — the largest & most elaborate haveli; five ornately carved golden sandstone mansions.
- Salim Singh Ki Haveli — iconic peacock-shaped roof; stunning -Rajput-Mughal architectural fusion.
- Nathamal Ki Haveli — the last of the great havelis; two symmetrical halves built by two brothers.
- Gadisar Lake (Gadi-Sar) — ancient artificial reservoir ringed by temples, shrines & carved gateways

### NOON — KULDHARA VILLAGE

- Visit the haunting ghost village of Kuldhara — abandoned overnight in 1825 by 1,500 Paliwal Brahmin families.
- Explore eerie ruins of stone houses & temples frozen in time — a UNESCO-protected heritage site



## AFTERNOON — SAM SAND DUNES (42 KMS FROM JAISALMER)

- Among the most famous dunes in Rajasthan, set in the heart of the Thar Desert.
- Massive dunes: 3 km long, 1 km wide, ~0.5 km high — constantly shifting with the wind.
- Completely barren terrain with whirling air currents rivalling the Sahara Desert.

## EVENING — SUNSET CAMEL RIDE

- Mount a camel and ride into the dunes as the sun descends over the Thar horizon.
- Watch the desert sky blaze amber & crimson — one of Rajasthan's most iconic sunsets.

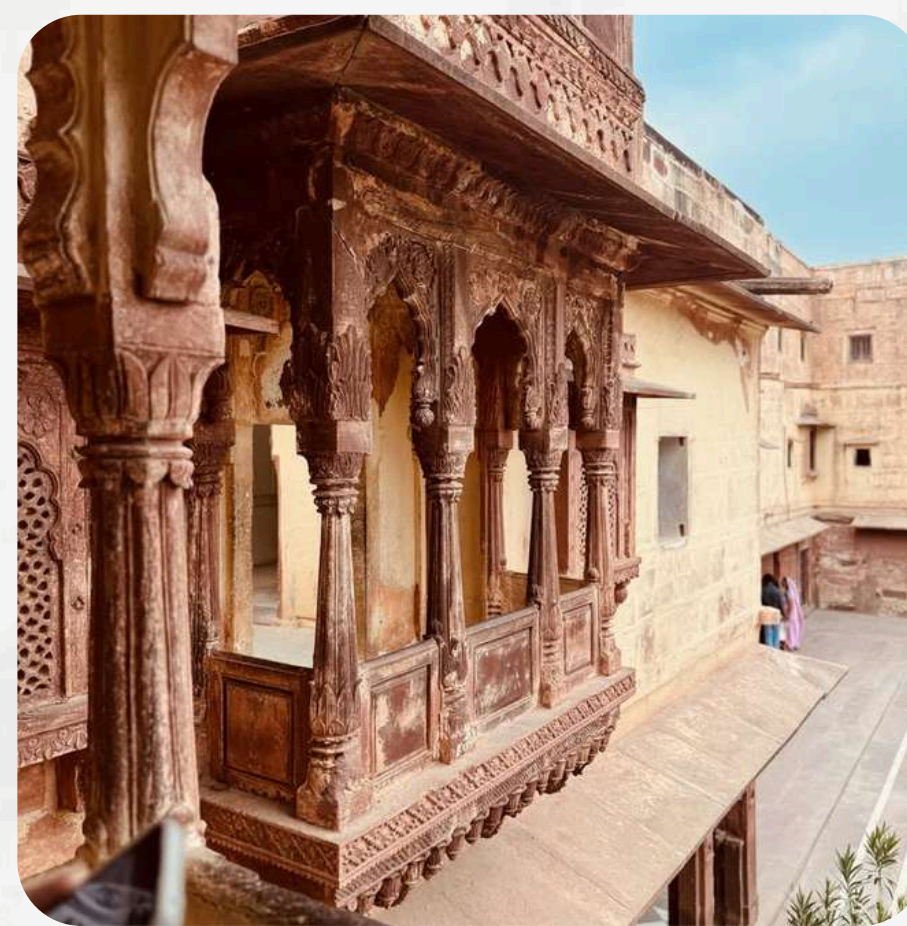
**Jaisalmer › Pokaran › Bikaner**

## MORNING

- Breakfast at the hotel in Jaisalmer.
- Check out and depart on the long desert drive towards Bikaner

## EN ROUTE — FORT POKARAN (BALAGARH)

- Built by the Rathore clan in rare yellow sandstone, a striking desert fortress.
- Houses a museum with weapons, costumes & Rathore-era artefacts.
- Historically significant as the site of India's nuclear tests (1974 & 1998).



## AFTERNOON — ONWARDS TO BIKANER

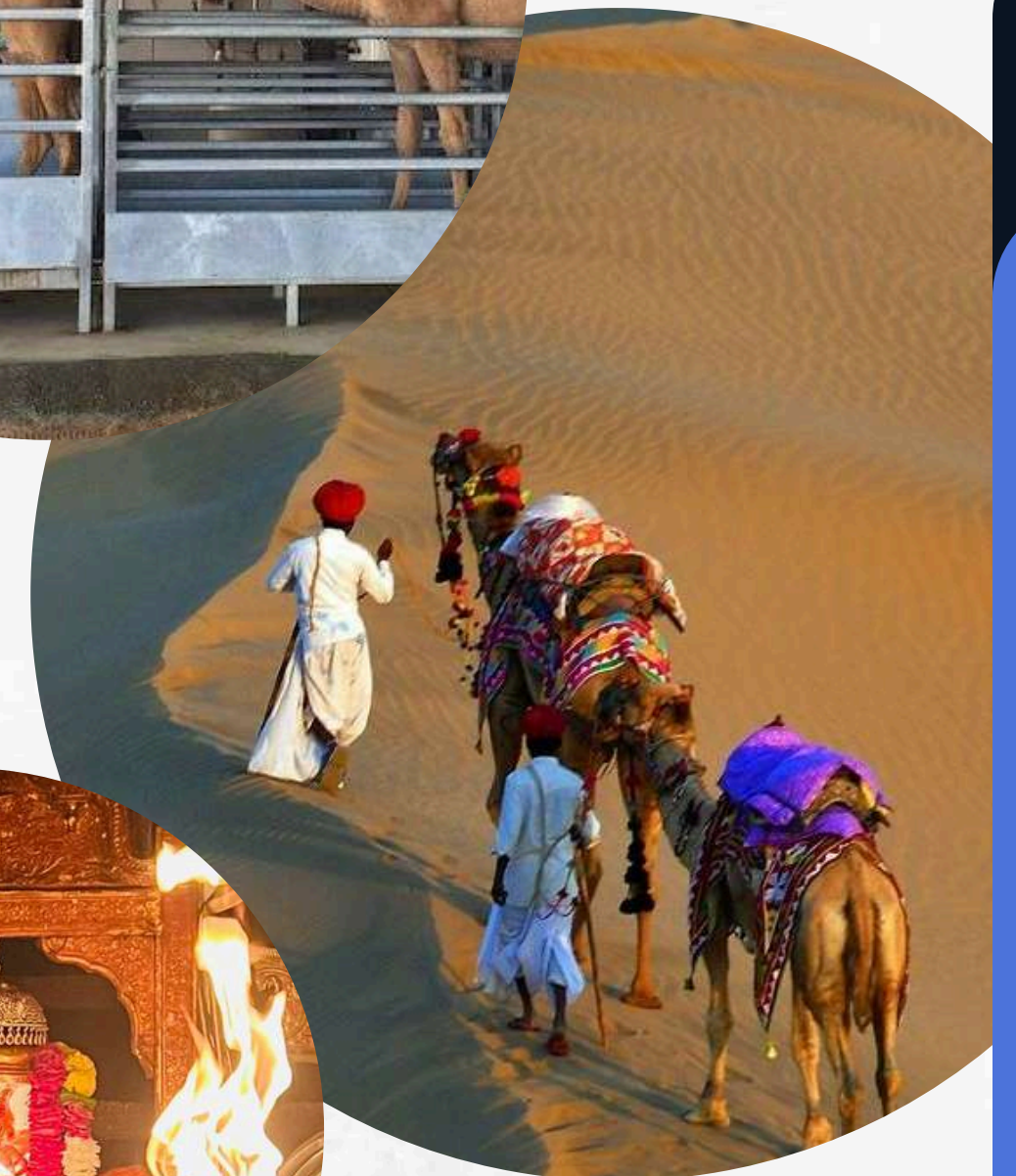
- Continue the drive through the golden Thar Desert landscape towards Bikaner.
- Arrive in Bikaner by late afternoon — transfer to hotel & check in
- Freshen up and relax after the long but scenic desert journey.



## COMING UP IN BIKANER

- **Junagarh Fort** — a magnificent, unconquered fort built in 1589 by Raja Rai Singh.
- **Camel Research & Breeding Farm** — home to India's finest camels; a unique desert experience.
- **Karni Mata Temple** — the famous 'Rat Temple' — one of Rajasthan's most extraordinary shrines.
- **Bikaner Bhujiyas & Sweets** — taste the city's legendary namkeens, a culinary heritage in itself.

## ITINERARY DETAILS

### MORNING

- Breakfast at the hotel in Bikaner.
- Check-out & depart for Mandawa

### EN ROUTE — KARNI MATA TEMPLE, DESHNOK

- Visit the ornate Karni Mata Mandir (Rat Temple) — built by Maharaja Ganga Singh in the early 1900s — which houses 20,000 sacred rats (kabbas) revered as holy incarnations.
- Marvel at intricate marble panels, silver & gold décor lining the entrance and interiors.

### AFTERNOON — ARRIVAL IN MANDAWA

- Arrive in Mandawa — the open-air gallery of Rajasthan. Transfer to the hotel & check in. EVENING — HAVELI WALK
- Explore the famous frescoed havelis of the Chokanis, Goenkas & Sarafs — extravagantly painted mansions dating from the early 1800s, blending religious themes with ornamental & European-influenced designs.

- Breakfast at the hotel in Mandawa.
- Check out & depart for Jaipur.
- **Mandawa Havelis** — Marvel at 18th & 19th-century mansions adorned with intricate frescoes and classic Rajasthani art.
- **Mukundgarh Fort & Havelis** — Explore historic architecture with beautifully preserved frescoes in this charming Shekhawati town.
- **Dundlod** — Visit the elegant fort and merchant havelis of this quiet, off-the-beaten-path Shekhawati gem.
- **Nawalgarh Havelis** — Discover the 'City of Havelis', including the famous Podar Haveli Museum and its stunning murals.

### AFTERNOON

#### ARRIVAL IN JAIPUR

Proceed to Jaipur — the magnificent Pink City & capital of Rajasthan. Transfer to hotel & check in.

### JAIPUR — LEOPARD SAFARI & CITY TOUR

#### EARLY MORNING — JHALANA LEOPARD SAFARI

- Transfer to Jhalana Leopard Reserve — India's first Leopard Reserve, opened in 2017, spread over 20 sq. km and home to 40+ leopards.
- Return to hotel for breakfast after the safari.

#### AFTERNOON — JAIPUR CITY TOUR

- Jantar Mantar (Observatory) — the world's largest stone sundial & a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds) — the iconic five-storey honeycomb façade, built for royal ladies to observe street life unseen.
- City Palace & Museum — royal residence with a fascinating textile section showcasing costumes of former Maharajas & Maharanis.



## EVENING — LOCAL BITES TO TRY

- Pyazz Kachori — flaky deep-fried pastry filled with spiced onions & potatoes.
- Moong Dal Cheela — savoury lentil pancake filled with fresh paneer.
- Lassi — thick, creamy yoghurt drink served in traditional earthen kulhads at local street stalls.



## SHOPPING — THE PINK CITY FOR WOMEN

- Bapu Bazaar — vibrant Bandhej & Leheriya textiles, mojris & traditional handicrafts.
- Johari Bazaar — exquisite Kundan, Meenakari & gemstone jewellery — a shopper's paradise.

JAIPUR › AMER FORT › ABHANERI › DEPARTURE

### MORNING — AMER FORT (11 KMS FROM JAIPUR)

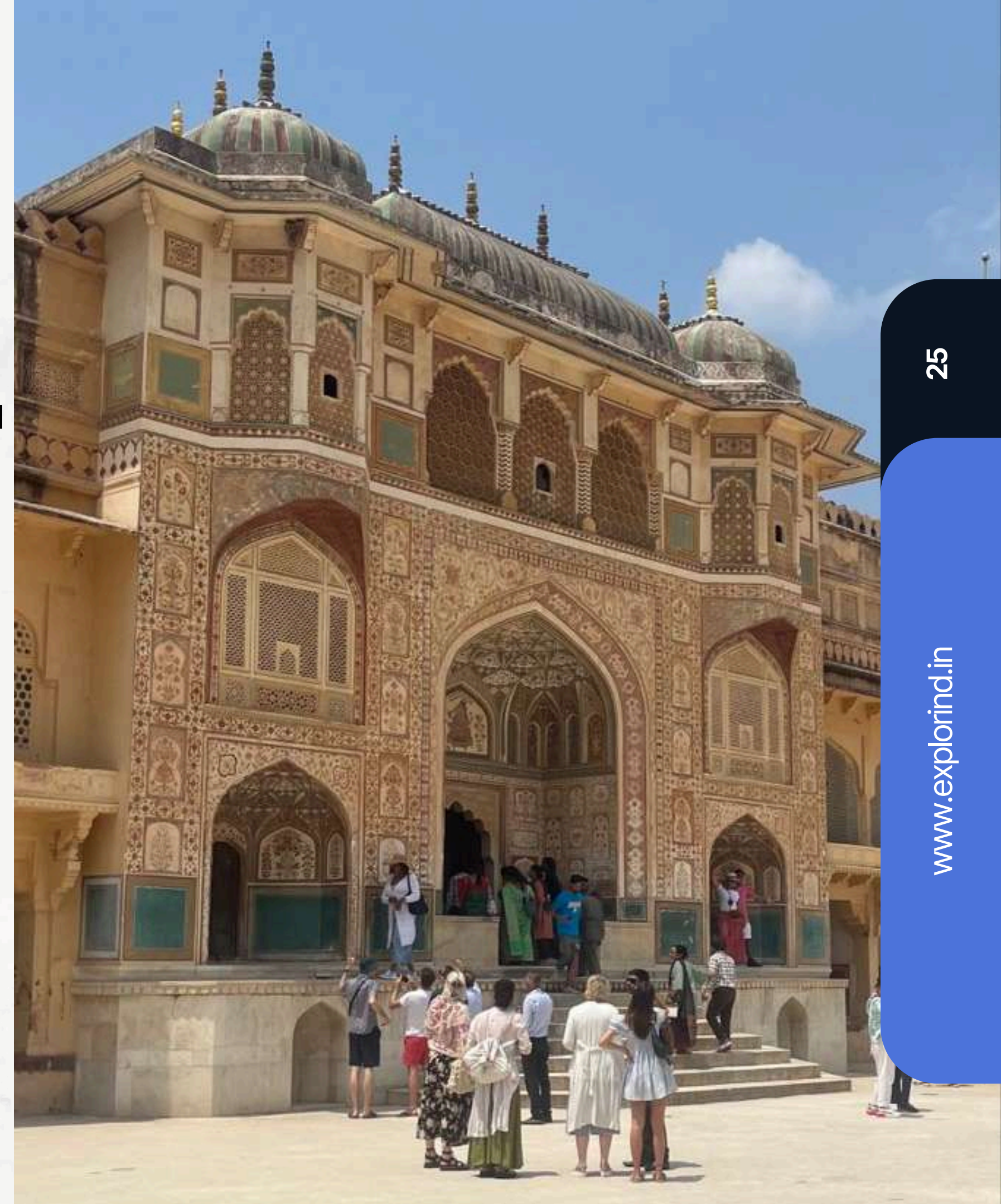
- Drive 11 kms to Amer Fort — the ancient capital of Rajasthan until 1728, perched dramatically on a hilltop.
- Elephant ride to & from the fort summit — a regal, unforgettable ascent (subject to availability).
- Visit the Temple of Kali, the Jai Mahal (Hall of Victory) and the serene Jagmandir.

### AFTERNOON — ABHANERI

- Chand Baori Step Well — one of India's finest geometrically designed step wells, with 3,500 steps descending 13 storeys into the earth.
- Harshat Mata Temple — a magnificent 2,500-year-old temple dedicated to the goddess of joy, located within the same complex.

### EVENING — DEPARTURE

- Drive back to Jaipur. Transfer to the airport/railway station for onward journey.
